01. 1. This matter is taken up through virtual mode.
2. Heard Mr. Debashis Mitra, learned counsel for the Petitioner and Miss. S. Mishra, learned Addl. Standing Counsel for the State.
3. Having regard to the severity of the allegations and the availability of the materials prima facie to show the complicity of the Petitioner in the occurrence, I am not inclined to allow the prayer for bail, which is, therefore, rejected. However, the learned Addl. District Judge, Salipur shall do well to try and

dispose of S.T. Case No.47/2021 as early as possible preferably within a period of six months, if there is no other impediment.
