1. This matter is taken up through virtual mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Addl. Standing Counsel for the State.
3. The petitioner is in custody since 24.08.2021 in connection with M.Rampur P.S. Case No. 88 of 2021 corresponding to C.T. Case No. 176 of 2021 pending in the Court of learned JMFC, M.Rampur for the alleged commission of offence under Section 395 of IPC.
4. Considering the submissions made, the materials on record, the period of detention has already undergone and the fact that, charge sheet has already been submitted in the case, I am inclined to allow the prayer for bail.
5. Let the petitioner be released on bail on such terms and conditions as the court in seisin over the matter may deem fit and proper to impose including the condition that the petitioner shall appear before the trial Court on each date of posting of the case without fail.

6. BLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
