This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite parties to release/sanction the legitimate arrear salary for the period from 07.06.1994 to February, 2001 as per the recommendation made under Annexure-7 and as has been given to other similarly situated persons under Annexure-8.

4. In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievance, the petitioner has made representation to the opposite party no.1 vide Annexure-10 and direction may be given to consider and dispose of the same, taking into account Annexures-7 and 8 within a stipulated time, to which learned Standing Counsel for S&ME Deptt. has no objection.

5. As agreed to by learned counsel for the parties, this Court without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, disposes of the writ petition directing the opposite party no.1 to take a decision on the representation filed by the petitioner vide Annexure-10, taking into account Annexures-7 & 8 and pass appropriate order in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of production of certified copy of this order by the petitioner.
