1. This matter is taken up through virtual mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Addl. Standing Counsel for the State.
3. The petitioner is in custody since 02.10.2021 in connection with Raikia P.S. Case No. 91 of 2021 corresponding to C.T. Case No. 296 of 2021 pending in the Court of learned JMFC, G. Udayagiri for the alleged commission of offence under Sections 417/493/376(2)(n) and 313 of IPC.
4. Considering the submissions made, the materials on record, the period of detention already undergone and particularly the statement of the victim recorded under Section 164 of Cr. P.C., I am inclined to allow the prayer for bail.

5. Let the petitioner be released on bail on such terms and conditions as the court in seisin over the matter may deem fit and proper to impose including the condition that the petitioner shall appear before the trial Court on each date of posting of the case without fail.

6. BLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
