1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Appellant and learned counsel for the State-Respondents. Perused the record as well as F.I.R.
3. Learned counsel for the Appellant seeks liberty to withdraw the present CRLA application and move a fresh bail application before the court below. Further, he submits that co-accused has already been released on bail by the learned court below.
