The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite parties to give her employment basing on the result vide letter No.1027 dated 18.08.2018 given by the opposite party no.3 and further to issue direction to the opposite parties no.1 and 2 to meet the official process for her employment for the post of Assistant Training Officer (ATO) in Painter and Decorator Trade at present (Painter General) Trade at I.T.I.
