2. 1. This matter is taken up through video conferencing mode.
2. The Petitioner in this writ petition seeks to assail the order dated 22nd October, 2021 (Annexure-3) passed by the Additional Tahasildar, Niali-Opposite Party in Mutation Case No.2451 of 2021.
3. In course of hearing, Mr. Nayak, learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that the Petitioner has a remedy under Rule 42 of the Orissa Survey & Settlement Rules, 1962 to assail the order impugned herein. Hence, he prays for withdrawal of the writ petition to avail statutory remedy.
