1. 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. By order dated 29.09.2022, the following order was passed :

“2. The writ petition has been registered before this Court on 3.2.2022 after the Original Application was transferred upon abolition of the learned Odisha Administrative Tribunal, Cuttack Bench, Cuttack.
