01. 1. This matter is taken up by video conferencing mode.
2. The Petitioners being in custody in connection with Buguda P.S. Case No.567 of 2021 corresponding to G.R. Case No.557 of 2021 on the file of learned J.M.F.C., Buguda, running for the commission of offence under section 294/323/341/325/506/307/34 of the IPC, have filed this application under section 439 of the Cr.P.C. for their release on bail.
3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and learned counsel for the State.
4. Taking into account the submissions made; further keeping in view the materials on records with other surrounding circumstances as also the period of detention of the Petitioners in custody and on going through the order passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge; in the absence of any such impediment; it is directed that the Petitioners be released on

bail in the aforesaid case on such terms and conditions as deemed just and proper by the court in seisin of the case.

However, it is made clear that in course of investigation, if any graver offence is said to have been made against the Petitioner, it will be open for the prosecution to move for cancellation of bail.

5. The BLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
