1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
 2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner as well as learned Additional Standing Counsel appearing for the State-Opposite Parties.
 3. The present writ petition has been filed by the Petitioner with the following prayers:-

“It is therefore prayed that in the facts and under the circumstances of the matter this Hon’ble court may graciously be pleased;

- 1. To admit the Writ Petition.*
- 2. To direct the Opp. Parties to disburse the arrear gratuity, leave surrender and other financial benefits.*
- 3. To pass any other alternative relief as deemed fit and just by this Hon’ble Court.”*
4. Considering the submission made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the Petitioner is directed to make a fresh representation before the Opposite Party No.2 by enclosing all

the relevant documents and citations in support of his claim, if any, within a period of three weeks hence.

5. It is observed that if such a representation is filed within the aforesaid period, the Opposite Party No.2 shall do well to dispose of the representation within a period of two months from the date of filing such representation. The decision so taken by the Opposite Party No.2 b communicated to the Petitioner within that time.
