1. The matter is taken up on through Video Conferencing Mode.
2. None appears for the petitioner at the time of call. From perusal of the brief, it appears petitioner has already filed a revision case registered as O.S. & S. Act. Rev. Case No.228 of 2021. For pendency of revision case on the self same purpose, the writ petition is not entertainable at this stage but however the writ petition stands disposed of permitting the petitioner to file petition showing urgency for expeditious hearing of the matter involved before the competent authority. In the event any such application is filed within a period of two weeks hence, same shall be considered and order, as appropriate depending on the urgency proved by the petitioner, be passed at least within a period of two weeks thereafter.
