01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners, learned Addl. Government Advocate for the State. Perused the records.
3. This is an application under Section 438, Cr.P.C. filed by the Petitioners for anticipatory bail, involving offence punishable under Sections 498-A, 341, 294, 323, 307, 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.
4. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the Petitioners that the allegation of assault is against one Madhab Ch. Sahoo, who is the husband of the victim. Petitioner No.1 is the mother-in-law and Petitioner No.2 is the cousin brother-in-law.
5. Considering the seriousness of the allegation, gravity of the offence and the facts of the case, although I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the Petitioners, however it is observed that, in the event the Petitioners surrender and move for bail before the learned
