3. Considering the submission of the learned counsel for the Petitioner that the order in E.C. No.315 of 1993 has come to be finalized through dismissal of O.J.C. No.7639 of 1998. For the Opinion of this Court, there should be logical end to the eviction order. In the process, this Court in disposal of the Writ Petition directs the Tahasildar concerned to see a logical end to the final order involving E.C. No.315 of 1993 provided there is no legal impediment by way of stay operating involving such order in any

forum by completing the entire exercise within a period of eight weeks from the date of communication of the order.
