01. 1. This matter is taken up by video conferencing mode.
2. The Petitioner being in custody in connection with Birmaharajpur P.S. Case No.133 of 2021 corresponding to Special G.R. Case No.10 of 2021 on the file of learned Court of Sessions –cum-Special Judge, Sonapur running for commission of offence under sections -20(B)(II)(c)/25/29 of the NDPS Act read with section-25/27 of the Arms Act, has filed this application under section 439 of the Cr.P.C. for his release on bail.
3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
4. Considering the submissions made, further keeping in view the factum of completion of investigation and submission of the charge-sheet after the rejection of the prayer for grant of bail to the Petitioner by the learned Sessions Judge, Sonapur, this application stands disposed of granting liberty to the

Petitioner to renew his prayer before the Court in seisin of the case for his release on bail by citing all such developments which have taken place in the meantime for their consideration in proper prospective.

It is needless to state that if such a move is made, the same shall be considered on its own merit without being influenced by this order and disposed of early in accordance with law.

5. The BLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
