This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

2. Heard.

3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite party no.1 to regularize the service period of the petitioner w.e.f. 01.04.2001 till 31.07.2003 and disburse the arrear salary, as has been given to other similarly situated persons vide letter dated 15.09.2017 and 01.02.2022, within a stipulated time.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to the opposite party no.1 vide Annexure-19 and the same may be directed to be disposed of within a stipulated time taking into consideration Annexures-13 series, 17 and 20, to which learned State Counsel has raised no objection.

As agreed to by learned counsel for the parties, however, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this writ petition stands disposed of directing the opposite party no.1 to consider the representation filed by the petitioner vide Annexure-19, taking into consideration Annexures-13 series, 17 and 20, and pass appropriate order in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of production of certified copy of this order.
