2. Heard Mr. A.K. Tarai, learned counsel for the petitioner, Ms. S. Patra, learned Central Government Counsel and Mr. S. Jena, learned Standing Counsel for School & Mass Education Department.
3. The petitioner has filed this application claiming for appointment as Education Volunteer under the EGS Scheme evolved by the Government.
