03. 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement (virtual/ physical) mode.
2. The Petitioner having been implicated in connection with Tirtol P.S. Case No.256 of 2016 corresponding to Special G.R. Case No.19 of 2016 on the file of learned Addl. Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge SC/ST, Jagatsinghpur running for the alleged commission of offence under section-376(2)(i)(n)/376(D)/506 of the IPC read with Section-6/14(3) of the POCSO Act and section-3(2)(v) of the SC & ST (PA) Act has filed this application under Section-438 of the Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in the event of his arrest in the above mentioned case.
3. Heard learned Counsel for the Petitioner and learned Counsel for the State as well as learned Counsel for the Informant.
