This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite party no.4 to pay the arrear refreshment bills of Rs.28,835/- to the petitioner within a stipulated time.
