3. The present Writ Petition has been filed with the following prayer:-

“ The petitioner therefore prays that this Hon’ble Court may be graciously pleased to admit this Writ application, issue notice, Rule NISI in the nature of mandamus or any other writ/writs as deem fit and proper, calling upon the Opposite Parties to direct the Opp. Party No.5 to consider the Annexure-6 dtd.19.10.2022 and inset the name of the petitioner in Displacement of Family compensation list instead of treated as a affected family and release the D.F. amount in favour of the petitioner within stipulated period”.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the Petitioner states that highlighting his grievances, the Petitioner has made a representation to Opposite Party No.5 vide Annexure-6 and the same may be directed to be considered within a stipulated time, to which learned Counsel for the State has no objection.
