3. The petitioner has been arrested in connection with Rajkanika P.S. Case No. 177 of 2020 corresponding to G.R. Case No. 289 of 2020 pending in the court of learned J.M.F.C., Aul for the alleged commission of offence under Section 376 of IPC..
