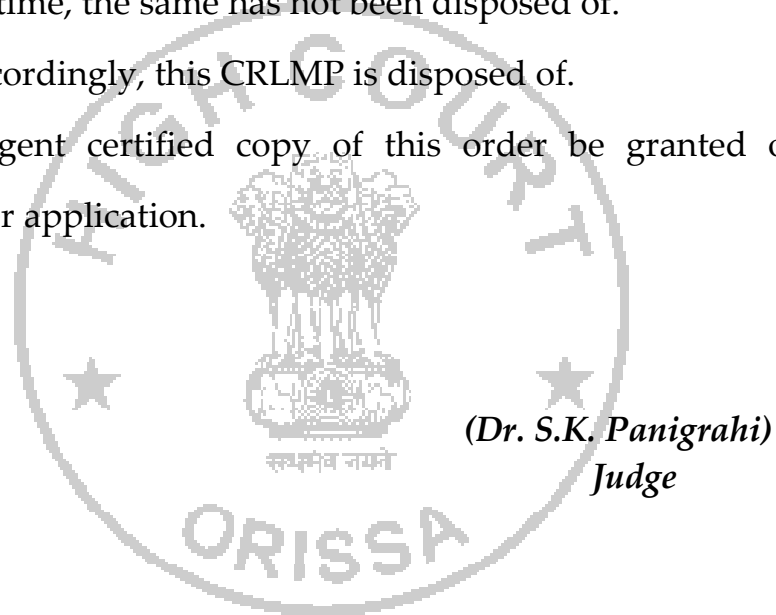
ORDER

01. 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement.
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and the learned counsel for the State.
3. According to learned counsel for the Petitioner, the grievance of the Petitioner in this case is that the Petitioner has filed a written report on 18.05.2022 before the Inspector In-Charge, Dhenkanal Police Station, (opposite party No.3) as well as a copy of it to the Superintendent of Police, Dhenkanal on the same day for registration. As no action has been taken by the said opposite party no.3, he prays that necessary direction be given to the opposite party No.3 to take a decision on the above noted written report within a specific time period.

4. Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court directs the I.I.C., Dhenkanal Police Station to take a decision on the written report in accordance with law, keeping in the mind the decision of the Supreme Court in the case of **Lalita Kumari v. Govt. of U.P. & Others**¹ within a period of four weeks from the date of production of certified copy of this order, if in the meantime, the same has not been disposed of.

5. Accordingly, this CRLMP is disposed of.

6. Urgent certified copy of this order be granted on proper application.
