This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite parties no.1 and 2 to consider her case for appointment to the post of Asst. Professor in the discipline of FMT pursuant to the advertisement in Annexure-1 taking into account the order dated 12.05.2022 passed by this Court in W.P.(C) No.16984 of 2020, within a stipulated time.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioners states that highlighting the grievance, the petitioner has made a representation to the opposite party no.1 vide Annexure-9 and direction may be given to consider and dispose of the same, taking into account Annexure-8 within a stipulated time, to which learned State Counsel has no objection.
