1. This matter is taken up through Video Conferencing mode.
2. This is an application under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure filed by the Petitioner for bail in connection with Khaprakhol P.S. Case No.130 of 2021, corresponding to G.R. Case No.705 of 2021, pending in the Court of the learned S.D.J.M., Patnagarh for alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 274, 275, 120(B) of the Indian Penal Code.
3. Upon consideration of the submissions made by the respective parties as well as on perusal of the records and on consideration of the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case and considering the fact that the petitioner is languishing in jail custody since 03.09.2021, I am inclined to release the Petitioner on bail in the above case, on furnishing a bail bond of Rs.30,000/- (Rupees Thirty thousand) with two local solvent sureties each for the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned court in seisin over the matter subject to condition that the Petitioner shall not indulge in such type of

offence while on bail and shall appear before the concerned Police Station every week preferably on every Sunday between 10 A.M. and 1 P.M.

4. It is further directed that the bail granted to the Petitioner is subject to the condition that learned court below shall verify whether the Petitioner has any criminal antecedent. In the event it is found that the Petitioner has any criminal antecedent, this bail order shall automatically stand revoked.

5. The BLAPL is accordingly disposed of.

6. As the restrictions due to resurgence of COVID -19 situation are continuing, learned counsel for the parties may utilize a print out of the order available in the High Court's website, at par with certified copy, subject to attestation by the concerned Advocate, in the manner prescribed vide Court's Notice No.4587, dated 25th March, 2020, modified by Court's Notice No.4798, dated 15th April, 2021, and Court's Office Order circulated vide Memo Nos.514 and 515 dated 7th January, 2022.
