01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Additional Standing Counsel for the State. Perused the case diary.
3. This is an application under Section 438, Cr.P.C. filed by the petitioners for anticipatory bail.
4. The petitioners are seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with G.R. Case No.314 of 2022, arising out of Raighar P.S. Case No.214 of 2022 pending in the court of learned N.G.N.-cum-J.M.F.C., Raighar for commission of offences punishable under Sections 493/417/506/34, I.P.C.
5. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that one Jiten Satnami is the principal accused in the present case. So far as the present petitioners are concerned, the only allegation against them is that they took the informant in their motorcycle and dropped her on the way and they have been falsely implicated in the present case.
6. Considering the nature of allegation, gravity of offence and the fact of the case, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the

petitioners. However, it is directed that in the event the petitioners surrender and move an application for bail before the learned court in seisin over the matter within a period of three weeks from today in the aforesaid case, they shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as would be deemed just and proper.

7. Accordingly, the ABLAPL is disposed of.
