 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
 2. None appears for the Opposite Parties at the time of call.
 3. This is an application for extension of time granted by this Court to file an application under Section 126(2) Cr.P.C vide order dated 26th April, 2022 by which the RPFAM was disposed of.
 4. Mr. Mishra, learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that due to some unavoidable circumstances, the Petitioner could not comply with the direction made in the order dated 26th April, 2022 by filing an application under Section 126 (2) Cr.P.C. within a period of three weeks from that date.
