02. This matter is taken up through Hybrid arrangement (video conferencing/physical mode).

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

This is an application under section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in connection with Narasinghpur P.S. Case No. 153 of 2021 corresponding to C.T. Case No.253 of 2021 pending in the Court of learned J.M.F.C., Narasinghpur for the commission of alleged offences punishable under sections 498-A, 304-B, 107, 306, 120-B/34 of the Indian Penal Code and section 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Perused the F.I.R. annexed to the anticipatory bail application.

Since the petitioner is the husband of the deceased,

who stated to have tortured the deceased physically and mentally for which she committed suicide and in view of the nature and gravity of accusation, while not inclining to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, liberty is granted to him to surrender and move for bail in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today in the event of which the learned Courts below shall dispose of the same in accordance with law expeditiously. The case records shall be made available to the Courts concerned for disposal of the bail application.
