01. 1. This matter is taken up by video conferencing mode.
2. The Petitioner being in custody in connection with Nilgiri P.S. Case No.137 of 2014 corresponding to C.T. Case No.188 of 2014 on the file of learned S.D.J.M., Nilgiri running for commission of offence under section 419/365/366/376/506/34 IPC, has filed this application under section 439 of the Cr.P.C. for his release on bail.
3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
4. Taking into account the submissions made; further keeping in view the materials on records with other surrounding circumstances as also the period of detention of the Petitioner in custody and on going through the order passed by the learned Sessions Judge; in the absence of any such impediment; it is directed that the Petitioner be released on bail in the aforesaid case on such terms and conditions as deemed just and proper by

the court in seisin of the case with further conditions that the Petitioner shall appear in person before the court in seisin of the case on each and every date of posting of the case till conclusion of the trial; will not terrorize or threaten the prosecution witnesses including the victim and will not indulge himself in commission of similar type of activity.

5. The BLAPL is accordingly disposed of.

Violation of any of the above condition(s) shall entail cancellation of bail.
