01. 1. This matter is taken up by video conferencing mode.
2. The Petitioners being in custody in connection with Rengali Dam Site P.S. Case No.173 of 2021 corresponding to G.R. Case No.2051 of 2021 on the file of learned S.D.J.M., Talcher running for commission of offence under sections 498(A)/306/34 IPC, have filed this application under section 439 of the Cr.P.C. for their release on bail.
3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and learned counsel for the State.
4. Taking into account the submissions made; further keeping in view the materials on records with other surrounding circumstances as also the period of detention of the Petitioners in custody and on going through the order passed by the learned Addl. Sessions Judge; in the absence of any such impediment; it is directed that the Petitioners be released on bail in the aforesaid case on such terms and conditions as deemed just and

proper by the court in seisin of the case with further condition that the Petitioners shall appear in person before the court in seisin of the case on each and every date of posting of the case till conclusion of the trial.

5. The BLAPL is accordingly disposed of.

Violation of any of the above condition(s) shall entail cancellation of bail.
