01. 1. This matter is taken up through virtual mode.
2. The Petitioners apprehending their arrest in Badachana P.S. Case No.418 of 2021 corresponding to C.T. Case No.1751 of 2021 pending in the court of learned J.M.F.C., Chandikhole registered for alleged commission of offence punishable under Sections 498-A/323/307/506/34 IPC and Section 4 of the D.P Act have filed this petition for their release on pre-arrest bail.
3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and learned counsel for the State.
4. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the State that the Petitioner Nos.1 and 3 have complied with the notice under Section 41-A of Cr.P.C. and they are not going to be arrested in this case.
5. So far as the prayer for pre-arrest bail of other Petitioner Nos.2 and 4 is concerned, learned counsel for the

State submits that Petitioner Nos.2 and 4 are not charge sheeted in the aforesaid case.

6. In view of such submission of the learned counsel for the State, learned counsel for the Petitioners does not want to press this ABLAPL.

7. Accordingly, this ABLAPL stands disposed of being not pressed.
