1. This matter is taken up through video conference mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the Parties.
3. The Petitioner instead of approaching under the statutory appeal remedy has moved this Writ Petition. This Court disposing of the Writ Petition as not entertainable at this stage permits the Petitioner to file an Appeal under the appropriate provision of law before the Appellate Authority within two weeks along with required Applications for condonation of delay and interim protection. In the event of any such Application filed, the delay shall be condoned and the Appeal shall be heard on its own merit besides the Application for interim protection shall also be taken up and decided. Till a decision is taken on the Application for interim protection, status quo as of now involving the disputed property shall be maintained.
