- 01.** 1. This matter is taken up by virtual/physical mode.
2. This Court vide order dated 14th November, 2017 while disposing of the writ petition bearing number W.P.(C) No. 662 of 2013 observed as follows:-

“**xxx** **xxx** **xxx** **xxx**”

Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on merit of the case, the impugned order is set aside and the matter is remitted back to the Collector & District Magistrate, Angul, for consideration afresh after giving opportunity of hearing to the parties.

It is open for the parties to adduce further evidence in support of their respective claim/cases which shall be considered by the authority on its own merit in accordance with law.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of.”

6. In view of the above, the contempt petition is disposed of as withdrawn.
