3. The present Writ Petition has been filed with the following prayer:-

“ (i) It is therefore the petitioner pray that your Lordship’s may graciously be pleased to admit the writ application, call for the records, issue notice to the opp. parties after hearing both the sides be pleased to direct the opp. parties to provide adequate compensation to the petitioner in lieu of the land which has been acquired by the M.C.L for the purpose of excavation of the coal in the interest of justice.”
