This matter is taken up through Hybrid arrangement (video conferencing/physical mode).

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the State.

This is an application under section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in connection with Chandanpur P.S. Case No. 378 of 2021 corresponding to G.R.. Case No. 3776 of 2021 pending in the Court of learned S.D.J.M., Puri for the commission of the alleged offences punishable under sections 341, 294, 323, 354, 307, 436/34 of the Indian Penal Code read with sections 4 and 5 of the Explosive Substances Act, 1908.

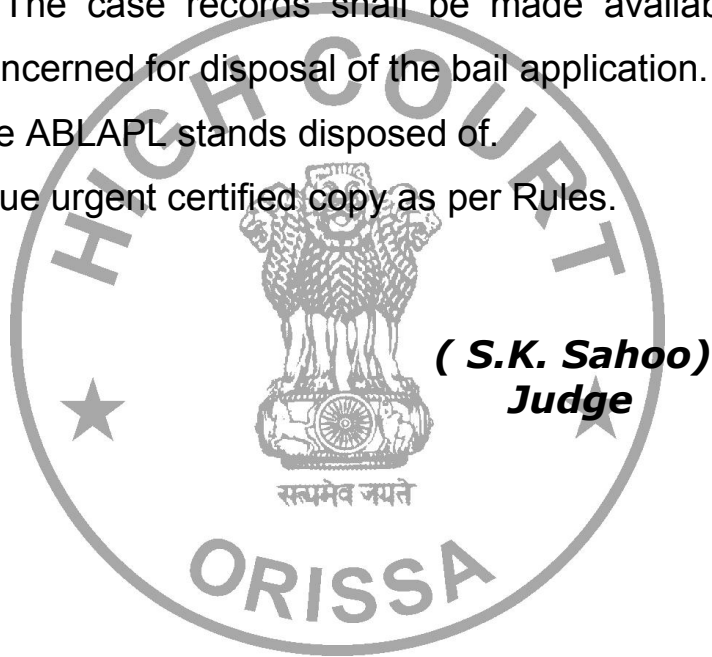
Perused the F.I.R. annexed to the anticipatory bail application.

It is a case where bombs were thrown at the house of the informant for which the house was burnt.

In view of the nature and gravity of accusation against the petitioners, while not inclining to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners, liberty is granted to the petitioners to surrender and move for bail in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today in the event of which the learned Courts below shall dispose of the same in accordance with law expeditiously and the claim of parity with the co-accused, who is stated to have been released on bail, shall be taken into account. The case records shall be made available to the Courts concerned for disposal of the bail application.

The ABLAPL stands disposed of.
