1. 1. This matter is taken up through video conferencing mode.
2. Heard Mr. N.R. Routray, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. S.K. Samal, learned Additional Government Advocate.
3. According to Mr. Jena, the petitioner is aggrieved by non-extension of the benefits either under Biju Pucca Ghar Yojana or Pradhan Mantri Abas Yojana though he is eligible to get the same. During course of hearing, he submits that liberty may be granted to the petitioner to file a grievance petition before the Collector, Jajpur (opposite party no.3) and further prays that a direction be given to the said opposite party to take a decision on such petition within a stipulated time period.
4. Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court grants liberty to the petitioner to approach the Collector, Jajpur (opposite party no.3) by filing a grievance petition

along with copy of this order through Registered Post within a period of one week. In the event such petition is received by opposite party no.3, he/she is directed to take a decision on the same in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of such petition and communicate the result of such exercise to the petitioner.

5. The writ application is accordingly disposed of.
