2. Heard.

3. The present Writ Petition has been filed with the following prayer:-

“Therefore it is humbly prayed that this Hon’ble Court may graciously be pleased to admit the writ and call for the record from the opposite parties no.2 and 3 and after hearing both the parties issue a writ/writs in the nature of certiorari/mandamus directing the opposite party no.3 to dispose of the petition under Annexure-5 and refer the matter to competent authority as per Section-64 of RFC&TLAR & R Act, 2013 forthwith in the interest of justice”.
