This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite party No.2 for settlement of the land in favour of the petitioner in Encroachment Case No. 4-1039/2022 by disposing of the show cause petition dated 28.10.2022 like other encroachers.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to the opposite party no.2 vide Annexure-4 and the same may be directed to be disposed of within a stipulated time, to which learned Counsel for the State has raised no objection.
