1. This matter is taken up through video conferencing.

2. This is an application under Sec.439 Cr.P.C. for bail and the offences alleged are under Secs.341/323/294/324/302/506/34, I.P.C.

3. Heard Mr.P.K. Biswal, learned counsel for the Petitioner as well as Mr. P.K. Pattanaik, learned A.G.A. for the State-Opposite Party.

4. Having heard both the parties and considering the statements of the witnesses including the eye-witnesses, namely, Bipin Kumar Jena and Ekalabya Patra, I am not inclined to release the Petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the prayer for bail is rejected.

5. The BLAPL is dismissed.
