This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite parties to consider his case for promotion to the Cadre of Sr. SES teacher from the date of which the batch-mate and juniors have been given promotion by correcting the gradation list.
