1. This matter is taken up through video conference mode.
2. Learned counsel for the Petitioner makes a statement that there is no challenge to the order at Annexure-3 and seeks a direction to the Tahasildar, Muribahal, O.P.3 to work out the direction contained in Annexure-3.
