1. The matter is taken up through video conferencing mode.
 2. Heard Mr. B.K. Mohanty, learned counsel for the Petitioners and Mr. P.K. Mohanty, learned Additional Standing Counsel.
 3. This is an application under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of bail to the Petitioners, namely 1) Jaga Bisoi, 2) Raju Paraja @ Butu and 3) Rabi Naik @ Reiv in connection with Jeypore Sadar P.S. Case No.224 of 2021 corresponding to G.R. Case No.781 of 2021 pending in the court of learned S.D.J.M., Jeypore for alleged commission of offence under Section 307/34 of the Indian Penal Code.
 4. Having heard both parties and considering the nature of injuries, I am not inclined to grant bail to the Petitioners. Accordingly their prayer for bail is rejected.
 5. The BLAPL is dismissed.
