This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to opposite parties to pay the encashment of unutilized Earned Leave as prayed by her at Annexure-5 with 12% interest from the date it was due till actual date of payment.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to the opposite party no.1 vide Annexure-5 and the same may be directed to be disposed of within a stipulated time, taking into consideration Annexure-3, to which learned Counsel for the State has raised no objection.
