1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and the State.
2. This is an application for bail U/s.438 Cr.P.C. filed by the Petitioner in apprehension of arrest for his alleged involvement in the offences U/s.147/148/341/294/427/186/283/353/307/506/149 IPC read with Section 3 and 4 of the PDPP Act.
3. Keeping in view of the nature of allegation, the circumstances appearing, the seriousness and gravity of the offences, while this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail, it is directed that in the event the Petitioner surrenders in connection with M.V. 79 P.S. Case No.58 of 2022 corresponding to G.R. Case No.296 of 2022 pending in the court of learned J.M.F.C., Motu within a period of two weeks' hence and moves for bail, he shall be released on such terms and conditions as would be deemed just and proper by the said court subject to verification of the criminal antecedent and

injury if not grievous with further conditions that he shall appear in person before the court below on each date of posting of the case unless specifically exempted by the court concerned; shall appear before the IO as and when required; shall not threaten or intimidate the Informant party in any manner whatsoever; shall cooperate with the investigation and with an undertaking before the concerned Police Station that he will not resort to sabotage the public order and tranquility in future. Violation of any of the conditions shall entail cancellation of bail of the Petitioner.

4. The ABLAPL is disposed of.
