3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to opposite party no.3 to dispose of her representation taking into consideration the judgment in ***Malaya Nanda Sethy v. State of Odisha***, 2022(II) OLR (SC)

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to opposite party no.3, vide Annexure-5 and the same may be directed to be considered and disposed of taking into consideration the judgment of the apex Court in ***Malaya Nanda Sethy*** (supra) within a stipulated time, to which learned State Counsel has raised no objection.
