3. This writ petition involves the following prayer.

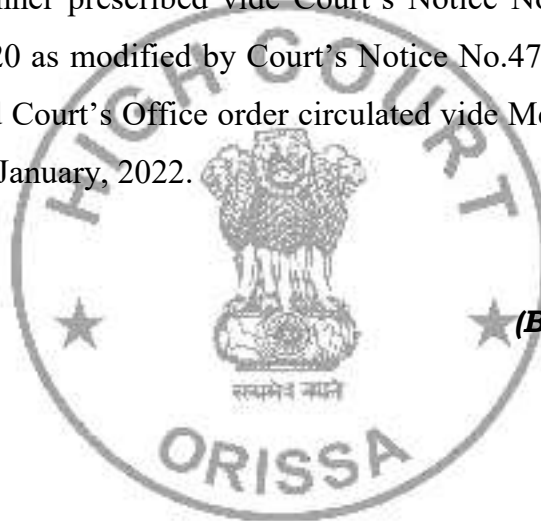
“In the above facts and circumstances, it is most humbly and respectfully prayed that this Hon’ble Court may graciously be pleased to admit the writ petition, issue notice to the Opp. Parties and after hearing the parties this Hon’ble Court may further be pleased to direct the Opp. Parties to include the petitioner’s name in beneficiaries list to get the “Ration Card” under Odisha State Food Security Yojana.

Further in alternatively, a direction to the OP No.2 may be given to dispose of the pending representation dated 21.10.2021 vide Anenxure-4 in accordance with the Odisha State Food Security Yojana within a stipulated time;

4. Looking to the limited request involved herein and as this Court finds the representation at the instance of the petitioner on the self same issue vide Annexure-4 is pending consideration, without

expressing any opinion on the merit of the case, this Court disposes of the writ petition directing the opposite party no.2 to look into the grievance of the petitioner vide Annexure-4 and take decision, as appropriate, taking into consideration the plea taken in the writ petition within a period of two months from the date of communication of an authenticated copy of this order along with copy of the writ petition by the petitioner.

As restrictions due to resurgence of COVID-19 situation are continuing, learned counsel for the parties may utilize a printout copy of the order available in the High Court's website, at par with certified copy, subject to attestation by the concerned advocate, in the manner prescribed vide Court's Notice No.4587, dated 25<sup>th</sup> March, 2020 as modified by Court's Notice No.4798, dated 15<sup>th</sup> April, 2021 and Court's Office order circulated vide Memo Nos.514 & 515 dated 7<sup>th</sup> January, 2022.
