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1. This matter is taken up through Video Conferencing Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel appearing for the parties.
3. Petitioner undisputedly has no complain for demarcation as of now. Mere filing of representation cannot seek the exercise of demarcation. There is a proper format and proper procedure has to be required to be followed in making such a complain. Considering petitioner has no pending application for demarcation as of now, this Court finds the writ petition is not entertainable. In the circumstance, this Court while disposing the writ petition as not entertainable for the time being, permits the petitioner, if so advised, may move proper application for demarcation at least within a period of ten days hence, in such event decision, as appropriate, shall be taken on such application by the competent authority however involving the parties likely to be affected
