1. This matter is taken up through virtual mode.
2. Heard A.K. Jena, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. D.K. Sahu, learned Standing Counsel appearing for the Railways.
3. The petitioner is in custody since 06.12.2021 in connection with RPF Post Puri Case No. 05 of 2021 corresponding to 2(C) C.C. No. 71 of 2021 pending in the court of learned S.D.J.M., Puri for the alleged commission of offence under Sections 3(a) R.P. (U.P.) Act.
4. Having regard to the submissions made, the materials on record and the fact that all the offences are triable by Magistrate first class, I am inclined to allow the prayer for bail. Let the petitioner be released on bail on such terms and conditions as the Court in seisin over the matter may deem fit and proper to impose including the condition that he shall personally appear before the trial Court on each date of posting of the case without fail.

5. The BLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
