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1. This matter is taken up through Video Conferencing Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel appearing for the parties.
3. This writ petition involves non-grant of certified copy under the application for grant of certified copy vide Annexure-5 Series. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that even though the application was filed since 12.8.2021, certified copy of the document involved is yet to be granted in favour of the petitioners. Mr.Mishra, learned Additional Government Advocate submits that since the application involving grant of certified copy of the document of the year 2008, it will taking some time.
