1. The matter is taken up on through Video Conferencing Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel appearing for the parties.
3. This case involves a direction for removal of encroachment. Undisputedly, there is already an application pending before the Tahasildar, Kujang-opposite party no.2 and as per the endorsement at the top of such application, it appears, the Tahasildar has already directed to the Revenue Inspector to visit, enquire and submit report. In the event of pendency of any such application, action, as appropriate, be taken however, keeping in view the provision under the O.P.L.E. Act and also involving the parties likely to be affected by completing the entire exercise within a period of four months from the date of communication of an authenticated copy of this order by the petitioner.
4. The writ petition stands disposed of with the observation and direction made hereinabove.
5. As restrictions due to resurgence of COVID-19 situation are continuing, learned counsel for the parties may utilize a printout copy of the order available in the High Court's website, at par with certified copy,

subject to attestation by the concerned advocate, in the manner prescribed vide Court's Notice No.4587, dated 25th March, 2020 as modified by Court's Notice No.4798, dated 15th April, 2021 and Court's Office order circulated vide Memo Nos.514 & 515 dated 7th January, 2022.
