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1. This matter is taken up through Video Conferencing Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel appearing for the parties.
3. The impugned order in the appeal involved herein was disposed of on 29.07.2013. This Court finds there is no satisfactory ground to entertain the writ petition after elapse of 8 years. Entertaining such delay matter may give way to disturb the settled position in the meantime. It is in this view of the matter and on account of delay, this Court is not inclined to entertain the writ petition which is accordingly dismissed.
