The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite parties to bring over the petitioner to the work charged establishment with effect from 11.02.2011 in terms of the order of the Tribunal dated 27.10.2016 passed in O.A. No. 65 of 2015 under Annexure-7 which has been implemented vide order dated 26.11.2021 under Annexure-9 with all consequential service and financial benefits.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made a representation to opposite party No.1 vide Annexure-6 series and the same may be directed to be considered within a stipulated time, taking into consideration Annexures-7 and 9, to which learned counsel for the State has no objection.
